Instructions for Camera Ready Paper Submissions to ICVGIP-Symposiums-24

Congratulations again on the acceptance of your work!

We are now providing the details regarding the submission of the camera-ready version. The deadline for submission for camera-ready versions across various symposiums is given below:

Track	Camera Ready Date
Young Researchers' Symposium	November 8, 2024
Young Faculty Symposium	November 8, 2024
Industry Research Symposium	November 8, 2024

Submissions should be in the form of a 2-page extended abstract, formatted according to the instructions available on the conference website.

We now discuss the three main steps that you need to complete for the successful registration and camera-ready paper submission.

Step 1: Paper Registration

- Each paper MUST have an author registration to the conference for it to appear in the ICVGIP 2024 website. Articles which do not have a registration by at least one author will not appear in the ICVGIP 2024 website.
 - Single registration can cover up to 2 papers, if an author has multiple papers.

- Student registration type is acceptable. However, student registration will cover the registration of a single paper.
- You do not need to register in the CMT system. However, you need to send an email to the respective symposium chairs confirming your participation to attend the symposium.

Step 2: Preparing Camera-Ready Paper

Paper length

The following are the page limits that should be strictly followed when preparing the camera-ready submission:

<u>All Symposiums</u>: Extended abstract should fit within two pages (including all images, and tables). References are not included in the 2-page limit and can be a maximum of 1 additional page.). Ensure that the paper is formatted according to the <u>instructions</u> available on the ICVGIP conference website.

Step 3: Uploading Camera-Ready Paper

- Once the final camera-ready manuscript has been prepared, please upload the PDF to arXiv (https://arxiv.org/list/cs.CV/recent) - Computer Vision and Pattern Recognition - and share the URL with the ICVGIP symposium chairs. This will help authors get citations for their work.
- The ICVGIP website will be updated with the arXiv links of all accepted symposium papers.
